





## SOMALIA INTERNAL DISPLACEMENT SOLUTIONS FUND (IDSF) - OVERVIEW SHEET

The Internal Displacement Solutions Fund (IDSF) was established by the Office of the Special Adviser on Solutions to Internal Displacement to the UN Secretary General. The IDSF is a "catalytic" fund that aims to support government-led solutions planning, strengthen accountability frameworks, and enhance multi-agency approaches to solutions.

The IDSF Somalia programme commenced in February 2024 and will run to July 2026. The first year of the programme provided support to the Federal Government of Somalia in the development of the landmark **Solutions Pathways Action Plan**. The plan lays out a government-led framework to support 1 million IDPs to advance towards solutions. The next stage of the programme will leverage support from participating agencies in implementing the plan.

Support people-centered solutions in urban areas through developing sustainable urban plans as well as economic and protection studies.















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

## **IDSF SOMALIA ACTIVITIES**

PATHWAY 1: Government leadership Coordination and technical support to the government-led Solutions Pathways Action Plan process

Development of a UN common framework to guide collective approaches to government-led solutions

PATHWAY 2: Access to basic services

Review of policies, regulatory frameworks and local development strategies, to inform the prioritization of basic services for displacement-affected communities

PATHWAY 3: Employment and livelihood opportunities

Private sector mapping to identify gaps and inform inclusive job creation initiatives

Technical assistance to support local government revenue collection

PATHWAY 4: Legal documentation, housing, land and property (HLP), and justice

Development of solutions-oriented HLP policies as well as urban/territorial strategies, to inform planning that is inclusive of displacementaffected communities

PATHWAY 5: Addressing climate change and building resilience

Development of sustainable solutions to urban planning in support of displacement-affected communities

PATHWAY 6: Data for solutions

Development of a National Data for Solutions Toolkit to strengthen government-led data systems

Implementation of the government-led Durable Solutions Progress (DSP) Survey, providing a baseline for the Action Plan

Thematic analyses (protection and economic) to inform development-oriented solutions initiatives
